

Dear Parent,

This four-hour educational program is for divorcing parents and focuses on the needs of children. Required for both parents by the Deschutes County Courts, the seminar is taught by a team of mental health professionals. Registration for the seminar is to be completed within 15 days of receiving notice of the educational requirement. The seminar is open to all parents regardless of where they live.

We know that divorce may create short and long-term struggles for children. We now also know that parents' actions and decisions have much to do with children's adjustment to divorce. The seminar focuses on children's needs throughout the divorce process and gives parents specific information and guidelines to follow to help meet those needs.

- Possible short & long-term effects of divorce on children
- The divorce/grief process for children & parents
- Expected changes in parent/child relationships
- Cooperative parenting
- Recommendations for residential schedules
- Placing children "in the middle"

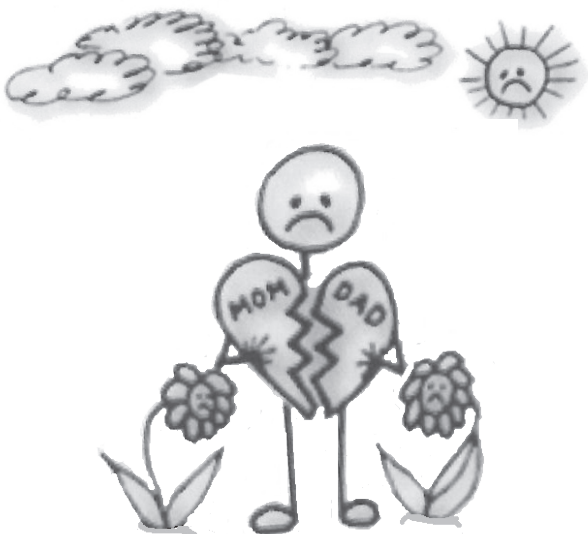
